Additional washrooms were made to lessen the crowding of students in the existing ones. A non-teaching staff member was made available throughout the day near each washroom to avoid any mis-happenings.

The Stage, Playgrounds, Library, Labs, Yoga, Meditation, Sports and Games, Music and Dance rooms were kept clean and upto the mark.

Nursery classrooms were made colourful and lively by adding different shades of colours and caricatures.

Remedial classes were efficiently organised after the school hours which helped a lot in improvising the cademics of the young Montfortians.

19 new teaching staff members, a watchman and 3 peons were recruited during this session. Few senior teachers left the institution as they got better job opportunities.

Attractive blazers were given to the teaching staff and Id-cards were made compulsory which enhanced the teachers with a presentable and professional look.

Teacher's excelling in art and craft were given extreme importance and they were motivated to showcase their talents which in turn led to the updation of all the pin up boards of our school in a well presented way as per the occasions. Teachers depicted their painting skills on pots and walls which added beauty to the school campus.
